### **Citations to the work by senior DRUID scholars**

### **What is the Social Sciences Citation Index?**

The Social Sciences Citation Index is a multi disciplinary database, with searchable author abstracts, covering the journal literature of the social sciences. It indexes more than 1,725 journals spanning 50 disciplines, as well as covering individually selected, relevant items from more than 3,300 of the world's leading scientific and technical journals. The Social Science Citation Index provides access to current information and retrospective data from 1973 forward. It averages 2,700 new articles per week which includes approximately 50,500 new cited references per week. This includes approximately 138 new cited references to patents each year. The Social Science Citation Index contains a current total of more than 3.15 million articles.

### **How to find the used database and data**

These citation data have been drawn from the Citation Databases of Institute for Scientific Information located on the Internet at:

Each of the authors has been looked up in the "Cited Reference Lookup" under "Full Search". Using their last name and first name(s) initial(s) a list of their publications appears. Marking the ones the author of interest has written and then continuing the search enables us to get a printout of information on the publication that has cited the author. Using these printouts, it was possible to add up the number of citations for each year (1990-1999).

### **Results**

The tables show the result of the citation result. The first table shows the gross amount of citation. That is every time the author has been cited. The second table shows how many times the author has cited himself. The third table shows the internal citations and is a count of the times other authors on the list have cited the author. And the last table shows the net citations. That is gross citation less self citation and citation from others of the implicated authors.
