### Knowledge Transfer Excursions

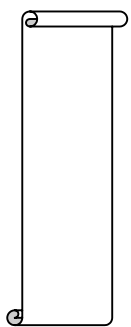
In keeping with this year's theme there are two strategic knowledge transfer excursions planned to facilitate learning about art and history on the afternoon of **Friday 13 June**.

#### ***Louisiana Museum of Modern Art***

Louisiana has a highly impressive collection of modern art that includes the works of many internationally recognized artists. The museum is comprised of a series of buildings set in stunningly beautiful park-like grounds overlooking the sound. The collection is presented very attractively and there are many interesting and provocative sculptures located indoors and outside in the grounds. There is a large museum shop with a comprehensive collection of Danish design items for sale. #### ***Kronborg Castle***

Kronborg Castle, the setting for Shakespeare's play about Hamlet, is one of the most significant Renaissance castles of Northern Europe. The castle is located at the narrowest point on the sound where Erik of Pomerania initially set up a fort in the 1400s to extract rents from all users of the waterway (obviously a chap with a keen sense of economics!). Among other attractions at the castle are fourteen of the original Kronborg Tapestries. For the DRUID group there will be a personal tour guide with a sense of humour to provide background on the key features of the castle and its grounds. <http://www.kronborg.dk/>
